 Classic and elegant with tiny bubbles, green apple and a long finish.
2. Brut di Pinot Nero Rosé, Ruggeri *Italy (12% abv)* 125ml Bottle £5.75 £26.00
 Medium and dry with a cranberry fruit intensity and a crisp finish.
3. Brut Baron De Marck *Champagne, France* £33.50
 Clean and soft with fruity nature bursting with apples and pears.
4. Taittinger Brut Reserve *Champagne, France* £49.95
 Crisp, citrus aromas with subtle toasty notes leading to an elegant, balanced palate with a lively mousse. half bottle £26.50
5. Laurent Perrier Rosé *Champagne, France* £75.00
 Elegant with soft, consistent bubbles, ripe red fruits such as raspberries.
6. Cuvée Dom Perignon 2003 *Champagne, France* £150.00
 Aromas of acacia honey, fresh almonds, apricots and toasted brioche.

 Hints of green apples with a balanced acidity and a long, fresh finish.
8. Pedro Ximenez Elki, Vina Falernia *Chile 2012* £17.50
 Floral and aromatic with a streaky minerality and fruity character.
9. Viognier IGP Pays d'Oc, Leduc *France 2012* £18.50
 Aromas of tropical fruit and sweet herb with rich, intense flavours.
10. Petit Chenin, Ken Forrester *South Africa 2012 (13.5% abv)* £3.50 £4.95 £19.50
 A youthful fresh wine with quince and pear drop flavours. Real freshness on the palate.
11. Pinot Grigio, MandraRossa *Italy 2012* £21.00
 Fresh and lively with tropical fruit flavours and a long, dry finish.
12. Sauvignon Reserva, De Gras *Chile 2012 (13.5% abv)* £4.10 £5.50 £22.50
 Citrus and melon aromas and flavours with fresh cut grass.
13. Exmoor Drive Chardonnay, Xanadu *Australia 2011* £23.50
 Ripe pear, white stone fruit, roasted nuts and a creamy complex finish.
14. Sauvignon Blanc, Mansion House Bay *New Zealand 2012* £24.50
 Medium to full bodied with crisp fruits and a long, zesty finish.
15. Hand Picked Riesling, Skilloogalee *Australia 2012* £27.50
 Fresh lemony fruits, orange blossom and melon, with a long, dry length.
16. Sancerre, Domaine des Vieux Pruniers *France 2012* £30.00
 Clean and fresh lemon and leafy aromas and citrus and mineral fruit notes.

 Well balanced with an intricate combination of fruit and acidity.

 Notes of grapefruit on the nose followed on the palate with floral and fruity notes.
19. The FMC, Chenin, Ken Forrester *South Africa 2011* £42.50
 Rich and layered with flavours of dried apricot, vanilla and honey.
20. Pinot Gris Réserve Personnelle, Trimbach *France 2007* £47.50
 A hint of honey on the palate, fascinatingly smoky and nutty.
21. Puligny Montrachet, Domaine Jean Louis Chavy *France 2011* £50.00
 Full yet elegant with citrus, honey and toasty oak flavours.

Rosé Wine

22. Zinfandel Rosé, De Gras *Chile 2012 (12% abv)* 125ml 175ml Bottle £3.50 £4.95 £19.50
 A full palate of pink grapefruit, pomegranate and honey with a hint of spiciness. Fresh and crisp with a lingering finish.
23. Pinot Grigio Blush, Via Nova *Italy 2012* £21.00
 Zingy citrus and red berry flavours finishing clean and refreshing.
24. Provence Rosé, La Vidaubanaise *France 2012* £4.10 £5.50 £22.50
 A light, bright nose of wild strawberries with a refreshing, smooth palate.

 Ripe fruit character with peppery spice and a balanced finish.
26. Podere Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Umani Ronchi *Italy 2012* £17.50
 Medium bodied and dry with a textured structure and ripe, plummy fruit. half bottle £9.25
27. Malbec, Sol, Bodegas Santa Ana *Argentina 2012* £18.50
 Soft, ripe blackcurrant flavours and a rounded and juicy finish.
28. Petit Pinotage, Ken Forrester *South Africa 2012* £3.50 £4.95 £19.50
 Spicy mulberries, plum pudding and cherries, with hints of smokiness.
29. Cabernet Sauvignon, Reserva, Vina Leyda *Chile 2011* £21.00
 Soft and structured with red fruit and gentle toast.
30. Merlot Reserva, De Gras *Chile 2012 (14.5% abv)* £4.10 £5.50 £22.50
 Fleshy fruit and oaky flavours, with notes of mint and velvety tannins.
31. Billi Billi Shiraz, Mount Langi Ghiran *Australia 2009* £23.50
 Medium body with blueberry, spices, subtle oak and a dry finish.
32. Rioja Crianza, Vina Cerrada *Spain 2009* £24.50
 Savoury, spicy fruit, well integrated oak and a lengthy finish.
33. Beaujolais Cuvée Traditionnelle, Vissoux *France 2012* £27.50
 Generous and ripe with juicy cherry fruits supported by subtle tannins.
34. Pinot Noir, Trinity Hill *New Zealand 2011* £30.00
 Silky with plums, blackcurrants and cherries followed by smoky oak notes.

35. Ixsir Altitudes Red *Lebanon 2010* Bottle £33.00
 Strawberries, oak and cassis on the nose followed by blackberry and cassis.
36. Chateau Vieille Tour La Rose, St Emilion Grand Cru *France 2009* £35.00
 Hints of ripe plums and damsons on the nose and palate. Rich and velvety.
37. Ribera del Duero, Crianza, Pago de Los Capellanes *Spain 2009* £41.00
 Aromas of spicy blueberries, plums, blackberries and anise.
38. Gevrey-Chambertin, Domaine Lucien Boillot *France 2011* £50.00
 Aromas of black cherries and raspberry jam precede a well balanced palate.
